They aim to guide visitors to accommodations that stand out for their unique hospitality concept, distinctive character, warm welcome, and extremely high level of service.

Just like the famous Stars that indicate the best culinary experiences in the MICHELIN Guide restaurant selection, the MICHELIN Keys reveal accommodations in the Guide’s hotel selection that offer the most outstanding stays. In this first domestic selection, and second selection worldwide, 124 accommodations earned distinctions. Nearly half are in California with recognized properties in West Hollywood outnumbering many other major cities and comprising 10 percent of all the state’s honorees. Pendry West Hollywood earned two MICHELIN Keys, while Chamberlain West Hollywood, Hotel 850 SVB, The Charlie, SoHo House Holloway, and Sunset Tower Hotel each earned one MICHELIN Key.
